Recommended Steps for Numbering Documents

- Complete the application through page 5, leaving all document number fields blank.
- Place your supporting documents in the order that they appear on pages 2-5. Place documents proving residency of an eligible ancestor in Montgomery County, Ohio with the other documents pertaining to that individual when ordering them.
- Create a list of the documents in their new order and number them once the list is complete.
- Place the document number in the appropriate fields on the application.
