Rockefeller Library; two living historical farms in Pennsylvania, Historic Bethlehem Partnership in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, and The National Watch & Clock Museum, Library and Research Center in Columbia, Pennsylvania, housing the largest horological collection in the world.

Just prior to assuming his position at the Ohio Genealogical Society, Noel was the Executive Director of the Age of Steam Roundhouse Museum in Sugarcreek, Ohio.
