# Researching Germans from Poland: One Family's Experience

**Today's Topic:** Karla Huebner, has done extensive research in records from Poland and Prussia. Both of her grandmothers were daughters of Norwegian immigrants to the U.S. Her paternal grandfather was the son of Germans from villages near the city of Posen. Karla's presentation will use what her family has learned in order to present resources and search methods that are specific to the Posen region, but are applicable more broadly to Germans from Poland.

**About the speaker:** Karla Huebner said she has always been interested in family history, but--not knowing about family group sheets and other handy tools--was daunted for years by her inability to draw decent trees for ancestors who seemed to think a family of ten was small. In the early 1990s she began using The Master Genealogist and continues to use it today.

Karla grew up in the Midwest and in California, with excursions around the rest of the US and, from time to time, Europe. Karla is a member of the Montgomery County Chapter OGS and volunteered with the Chapter's DNA Interest Group. When not doing genealogy, she writes and currently has three books in print.
