INTRODUCTION

Purpose of this Report

Approximately 20 years ago, the Montgomery County Chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society (MCC-OGS) embarked on a project to read inscriptions on Cemetery tombstones for all of the Cemeteries in Montgomery County. To date, six (6) Volumes including fifteen (15) Books have been published covering seven (7) of the fourteen (14) Townships in the County.

This Report is intended to review the progress to date for the project and to identify the remaining work to be done.

The reference section in this Report lists some of the Cemetery readings that have been done for the Townships remaining to be published.

Notes

1. Refer to the 2002 Cemetery Atlas [1] for much historical and detailed information regarding the Cemeteries and this Cemetery Report. The location information and the alphabetical index of all cemeteries with their alternate names are of special value. The five categories included in the 2002 Atlas have been reduced to three for this Report

2. The numbers contained in this Report are based on the numbers of Cemeteries involved. The number of individuals in each Cemetery varies from a few (in some cases, the number is unknown) to over 100,000. Therefore, the importance and significance of each Cemetery varies.
3. With population growth and the incorporation of many towns and cities, the township boundaries become less obvious and significant. The locations of cemeteries in the Atlas [1] and in this Report are based on the original township boundaries for ease in reference.
4. The Montgomery County Chapter of Ohio Genealogical Society has a section in their Internet web site of Online Cemetery Listings [26]. This site has been developed by Carolyn Johnson Burns and material is currently being added. It includes "some cemetery readings and corrections to materials published by the Montgomery County Chapter". This site will continue to expand with new information and provides material to compliment the MCC-OGS project.
5. There are various nationwide Cemetery Transcription Projects on the Internet. These include
1) Tombstone Transcription Project, 2) Interment.net, 3) Find A Grave, 4) USGENWEB Project ,
5) AHGP Ohio Cemetery Transcription & Photo Project, and 6) The Political Graveyard.
To date, a limited number of cemeteries from Montgomery County are included. As stated in the listings, these are not a complete listing of burials. The records were provided by contributors to each project. In addition, the listings do not identify the location within the cemetery, such as Section or Row. These projects will continue to expand with new information and provide material to compliment the MCC-OGS project. See numbers [28] through [33] in Reference section for more information about each project.
6. A master list of all individuals listed in the MCC-OGS Cemetery Inscription publications is being compiled by Steve Malachinski in Chicago. This list will continue to expand as additional cemeteries are read and published.
7. In the Summary section of this Report, there is a column titled "Cannot read". The reasons for this include Extinct Cemeteries, unknown locations, bodies have been relocated to another cemetery, current Owners / Operators will not allow MCC-OGS to read or photograph their cemetery, not published at this time due to the size of the cemetery, readings have been published by others, records are available from the Cemetery Office or Church, or other causes.
In some cases, there are records or earlier readings which can be used to list those individuals who were originally interred there. In these cases, this material will be included in the MCC Volumes with appropriate comments and credit given.
8. Cemetery readings and burial information exist in many other sources such as Government Records – for example, County and City Death Records - and in Cemetery and Church Records. More research is needed to identify these sources for additional reference information.
9. For those Cemeteries that are active and were read and published several years ago, an Update might be considered after all of the Cemeteries are finished and included in the MCC published volumes.

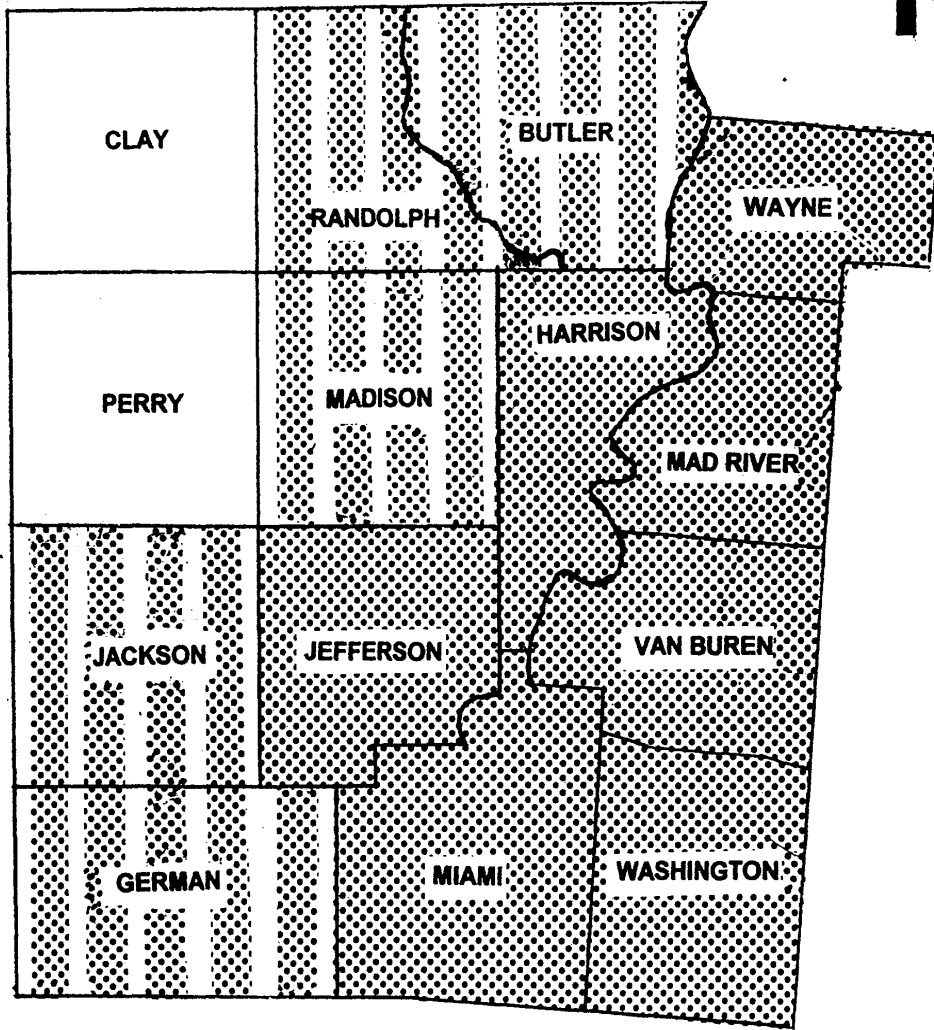
