However in 2013, we created this book so that future Daughters would be able to go on their own and find our Revolutionary War Patriots.

## **Other Montgomery County, Ohio Revolutionary War Soldiers**

The Jonathan Dayton Chapter NSDAR made an effort to determine every Revolutionary War Soldier in Montgomery County during Kathleen LAURI-LEWIS' (NSDAR# 830798) term as Regent. In completing this project, we discovered that there were a number of Revolutionary War Patriots that no longer had a grave marker of any kind. During Betsie GOAD'S (NSDAR# 797413) term as Regent, the plaque with 30 Revolutionary War Soldiers' names listed was dedicated on 18 May 2013.



## **Map of Woodland Cemetery**




## Hugh ANDREWS

Hugh ANDREWS was born 31 Aug 1764 at Hanover Twp., Dauphin Co., PA. He first married Miss Anne SPEAR and later Elizabeth AINSWORTH. He died 17 may 1811 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a Captain for PA during the Revolution. No Daughters have joined under Hugh ANDREWS in the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (NSDAR). He is buried in Lot 463, Section 8.




Figure 5 Section Map for John BARNETT




Figure 6 Tombstone of Simeon BROADWELL




Figure 8 Section Map for Simeon BROADWELL

John DAVIS was born 19 Aug 1758 near Amsterdam, Holland. He first married Jane and later Nancy Lee LANE. He died 24 Feb 1842 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a PVT during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot# is A030455. He is buried in Lot 934, Section 65. His daughter, Mary married Hiram WYATT. They are also buried in Lot 934. Their daughter, Mary K WYATT (NSDAR# 181916) was a member of the Jonathan Dayton Chapter of NSDAR. She is also buried in this lot.




Figure 9 Section Map for John DAVIS

Figure 12 Tombstone for John ELLIOTT





Figure 13 Section Map for John ELLIOTT




Figure 19 Section Map for John GRIMES

James HANNA was born 2 Mar 1752 at Monaghan Co., Ireland. He married Hannah BAYLESS on 4 Apr 1782. He died 31 Oct 1827 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a PVT for MD during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A051171. He is buried in Lot 621, Section 16.




Figure 22 Section Map of James HANNA




Figure 24 Section Map for Enoch HASKINS, Jr.


## William KING

James MCCANDLESS, Jr. was born Feb 1760 at Chester Co., PA. He married Margaret JOHNSON on 25 Jan 1786. He died 17 Feb 1846 in Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a Sub-Lieutenant for PA during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A074698. He is buried in Lot 229, Section 78.




Figure 28 Section Map for James MCCANDLESS

#### **Alexander McConnell**

Alexander MCCONNELL born 26 Jan 1758 in Scotland. He married Rebecca THOMPSON in 1793 in KY. He died 12 Nov 1821 in OH. He was a Private for VA during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A075455. He is actually buried in Beavertown Cemetery, but a memorial was placed at Woodland. It is located in Lot 154, Section 23.




Figure 30 Section Map for Alexander MCCONNELL

Robert PATTERSON was born in 1759 at Bedford Co., PA. He married Elizabeth LINDSEY on 20 Mar 1790. He died 5 Aug 1827 in Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a Captain for VA during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A086460. He is buried in Lot 2871, Section 13.




Figure 32 Section Map for Robert PATTERSON

#### **Isaac Peirce**

Isaac PEIRCE was born 8 May 1749 in Charlestown, RI. He married Mary SHEFFIELD. He died 7 Sep 1821 in Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as an Aide-de-Camp for RI during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A091334. He is buried in Lot 24, Section 77 under the bush behind the rock and cross with books leaning against it.




Figure 33 Tombstone for Isaac PEIRCE




Figure 35 Section Map for Isaac PEIRCE

### **Daniel PIERSON**

Daniel PIERSON was born 25 Apr 1750 at Morristown, Morris Co., NJ. He married Prudence KING. He died 11 Dec 1831 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant in the Revolution. No Daughters have yet joined NSDAR under Daniel PIERSON. He is buried in Lot 466, Section 59.




Figure 36 Tombstone of Daniel PIERSON




Figure 37 Section Map for Daniel PIERSON

## **Alexander SIMPSON**

Alexander SIMPSON was born 2 May 1763 at Elizabethtown, Essex Co., NJ. He first married Elizabeth CALDWELL on 8 May 1788 and then Elizabeth LYNCH on 30 Dec 1832. He died 20 Mar 1834 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a Private and a Drummer for NJ during the Revolution. His stone lists Alexander SIMPSON, Elizabeth CALDWELL, Moses STOUT and Phoeby EDDY. Moses and Phoebe STOUT'S son David married Alexander and Elizabeth CALDWELL SIMPSON'S daughter, Electa. Alexander's NSDAR Patriot # is A104110. He is buried in Lot 682, Section 99. Alexander, David and Electa are the only ones that shows up in Woodland Internment Database.




Figure 40 Section Map for Alexander SIMPSON

#### **Isaac Spinning**

Isaac SPINNING was born 3 Oct 1759 at Elizabeth, NJ. He married Catherine PIERSON on 13 Jan 1785 at Morristown, NJ. He died 24 Dec 1825 at Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH. He served as a Private and a Minute Man for NJ during the Revolution. His NSDAR Patriot # is A107276. He is buried in Lot 444, Section 89.




Figure 43 Section Map for Isaac SPINNING




Figure 45 Section Map for Robert Strain

### **Maj. David Zeigler**

Maj. David ZEIGLER was born 16 Jul 1748 at Heidelberg, Germany. He married Lucy Anna SHEFIELD on 22 Feb 1789 at Marietta. He died 24 Sep 1811 in Cincinnati, OH. He joined the Army of the Revolution in 1775 and served until the Treaty of 1783 was acknowledge. No Daughters have yet joined under Maj. David ZEIGLER. He is buried in Lot 4, Section 65.




Figure 50 Maj. David ZEIGLER Tombstone
